Kelly (2009) Include the name of the author, year, and page number if a part of a work is directly quoted. A PDF, after all, is not really a source itself, but rather a file type and a way for displaying that source. For example, if the source you wish to cite is a PDF of a newspaper article, cite the source as you would a newspaper. Unless you're citing directly to a specific chapter in the textbook, the title comes immediately after the names of the authors or editors. Capitalize the first and last words of the article or chapter title, as well as any other major words.
